#### **On Line Meetings**

With the restrictions placed during the COV19 pandemic, we are now only having online Lions Club meetings. Our first online meeting had 16 members and one guest!! Thanks to everyone who logged in or dialed in or both to attend our meetings. Spike Garcia of Lone Survivor spoke with us about their program to help veterans adjust to life after the military. Their goal is to help veterans and family members to cope with pain, PTSD, brain injury, etc, by using mental health therapy techniques. This is their 10 year anniversary. It is open to all veterans of combat, regardless

of age or war fought. Their facility is located in Crystal Beach, Galveston. The five day program is provided at no cost for air fare, lodging, meals, or program. At our second online meeting, with 14 members and one guest, Josh Plumley of Gracewood explained how that program helps single mothers and their children repair and redirect their lives. They offer safe shelter, hope for a brighter future with career or educational training, and safe a environment for their children. Through counseling, healing of the brokenness and trauma the family has endured is conquered. Although not as nice as actually having the speaker in our presence, these online meetings continue to keep us connected yet safely separated.

#### **HRF Request**

At our Last meeting, Lion Kim Fenney informed us of an 8 year old boy in need of prosthetic eyes. A few years ago he had one eye removed due to Retinoblastoma, cancer of the eye. He was doing well in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, learning Braille and keeping up with this school work. Recently he had to have the other eye removed for the same reason. He needs the two prosthetic eyes to keep the shapes of the eye sockets to prevent deformity of his face, and for him to appear

more normal. The child is undergoing chemotherapy, and is quite sick at present. We will offer to send him to Texas Lions Camp next year. Lion Chuck has submitted the necessary paperwork to the Humanitarian Relief Fund for \$2000, which we will pay \$ 1000. Please keep this young man and his family in your thoughts and prayers.
